Care Instructions

Stains

Smaller stains and dirt can be removed with a moist cloth or sponge.

Yearly Cleaning

Regardless of where your rug is positioned, we recommend thoroughly cleaning it once a year — for example, before putting it away for winter. Simply use a garden hose and brush or a pressure washer (e.g., Kärcher). Be sure to maintain a distance of at least 50 cm and work with deep pressure.

Cleaning Agent

A standard household cleaning agent can help.

Waterlogging

Be sure to prevent waterlogging under the rug.

Winter Storage

If you put your rug away for the winter, we recommend cleaning it and allowing it to dry first and then storing it rolled up.

Unboxing

Your rug has been in transit for several days when it arrives, so give it a chance to recover.

Lay it out flat and smooth out the wrinkles – repeat until smooth. Warm temperatures, sunlight, and underfloor heating can accelerate this process.
